SCOPE OF THE CONFERENCE

APCOM provides a unique opportunity for experts in the field of applied physical research of condensed matter to come together and share their visions of future development in the area of application of devices for example in electrical and nuclear power engineering, electronic and optical communication etc. The main focus of the conference is on presentation of both theoretical and experimental results, partly also of both computer simulation results and specific measurement techniques in the investigation of physical properties and structure of bulk solids and structures, thin solid films, ultrathin organic polymer films, micro- and nanostructures etc., exposed to the influence of wide-range specific external factors (electrical, magnetic, thermal, highfrequency electromagnetic waves, optical and ionized radiation, ion and elementary particles beams etc.).

Main content areas:

- 1. New materials and structures (incl. nanostructures and thin films), their analysis and specific applications.
- 2. Physical properties and structural aspects of solid materials and their influencing.
- 3. Optical phenomena in materials, photovoltaics and photonics, new principles in sensors and detection methods
- 4. Nuclear science and technology (with emphasis on the influence of irradiation on physical properties of materials and radiation detection).
- 5. Computational physics and theory of physical properties of matter.
- 6. Biophysics and interdisciplinary physics of condensed matter.

SCIENTIFIC PROGRAMME

Contributed (10-15 min) oral presentations including discussions are planned. The preliminary scientific programme of the conference includes more than 90 contributed papers. No posters. The official language of all presentations is English and Slovak (Czech). English is strongly recommended. Each participant can present only one contribution.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Registration: Registration and lodging of participants will be provided at the registration desk, which will be opened at Hotel Patria, Štrbské Pleso on Wednesday, June 20th from 09:00 to 13:00 CET. Lunch at 12:00 to 14:00 CET. Opening ceremony at 14:30 CET.

Presentation facilities: A PC video-data projector (Microsoft® PowerPoint® 2003 software is recommended) will be available for oral presentations. If you need some special equipment, hardware or software, please contact the conference administrator.

Social events: The *welcome party* will be held on June 20th at 20:00 CET. Either a mountain tourist walk and/or excursion in the vicinity are planned for June 21th from 14:00 to 18:00 CET. The *friendship party* will be held on June 21th at 19:30 CET. Departure of participants on June 22th at 13:30.

Venue: The workshop will be held in Hotel Patria, High Tatras, Slovak Republic. It is located as a dominant building near the high-mountain tarn Štrbské pleso (1,355 metres above sealevel) at the mouth of Mlynická Valley, sensitively incorporated into the High Tatras landscape. CALL FOR PAPERS

All accepted papers will be published in peer-reviewed Conference Proceedings. The conference participants will obtain Conference Proceedings at the registration desk. Details for publication in Conference Proceedings and in Journal of Electrical Engineering are described below.

Instructions for publication in Conference Proceedings: All complete texts of papers will be written in English according to the template available on the conference webpage. The authors are requested to submit the papers in electronic form of the camera-ready paper as a file written in the text editor Microsoft Word (*.doc or *.rtf only) to the e-mail address jan.vajda@stuba.sk by April 30, 2010. The program committee will send the copies to referees and supervise the reviewing process. Contributions received after this date may not be included in the Conference Proceedings. One main author can publish only one contribution in Conference Proceedings.

Instruction for publication in JEE

The authors are encouraged to submit an extended version of their work to the Journal of Electrical Engineering (JEE) indexed in Thomson-Reuters SCIE, Scopus Elsevier, INSPEC, IET and ADS Harvard *, last impact factor: 0.278. Only electronic files (MS Word format or LaTeX file) will be collected at the reception desk during the conference. The manuscripts should represent original work not previously published and not being considered for publication elsewhere.
